Our adventures include the amazing Trees Of Mystery Redwoods & Gondola ride through them; the US Mail Boats – an exciting 54 mile Jet Boat excursion along the Rouge River; the Big Buggy Tour – an exhilarating dune buggy ride along the protected Oregon Dunes with amazing views of the Ocean and more; the Sea Lion Caves located just north of Florence – and a chance for you to see these massive creatures up close and personal in their native setting; the Tillamook Cheese Factory – because what trip along the Oregon Coast would be complete without a stop at the brand new visitor’s center; The Evergreen Aviation & Space Museum – now the home to the Spruce Goose and so much more; and the Wildlife Safari – a drive through safari where a local guide will board our coach and tell us all about the local residents as we pass through. Also included are a some of our hotels that feature spectacular ocean views and our coach will travel along the coastline wherever possible.

**Day One: Wednesday October 9, 2019 B, L**

A Continental Breakfast will be served on board the coach this morning (as well as snacks & beverages throughout the tour) as we depart Carson City & Reno and start our vacation. Comfort Stops will be made as we travel through the forests and to Mt. Shasta where a hosted lunch is included. After lunch we'll continue on to Roseburg Oregon, our home for the evening.

**Day Two: Thursday October 10, 2019 B, L**



Breakfast is included at the hotel this morning before we board our coach and head west to the Coast. Our first stop: Trees of Mystery, The Premier Nature Attraction on California's North Coast. Situated right in the center of the Redwood National and State Parks, they are California's original redwood Nature Attraction and have been welcoming visitors to this part of the world since 1946. Explore a groomed interpretive trail through the awe-inspiring redwoods. Part of the trail (the Trail of Tall Tales) is devoted to the mythology of Paul Bunyan, America's larger-than-life logger from the turn of the century. One of the most appealing and exciting features of the entire Trees of Mystery experience is the journey through the forest tree tops via the unique SkyTrail gondola ride.

We'll continue north into Oregon and just past Brookings, we'll follow the Samuel Boardmen Scenic Corridor for great views as we head on to the Best Western Gold Beach Inn for our two-night stay. Located on the ocean with great views from all of the rooms, we're within short walking distance to several restaurants where you can enjoy dinner at your leisure.



**Day Three: Friday October 11, 2019 B, L**



Breakfast is included at the hotel before we head off for our day excursion on board the US Mail Boats – 64-mile round trip on the Rogue River! Follow in the footsteps of history just as Rogue River pioneers have done since 1895, when road access did not exist. The Jetboat is capable of traveling in just inches of water but the ride is relaxed and is great for the travelers who seek a scenic experience. The Pacific Coastal Estuary, abundant wildlife, pristine wilderness and mail boat history make this jet boat tour memorable for all ages. Lunch is included at the historic community of Agnes. Our return to Gold Beach is scheduled around 2:30pm and you'll have the rest of the afternoon and evening to explore Gold Beach.

**Day Four: Saturday October 12, 2019 B**



Breakfast is again included this morning before our departure. We'll travel north to Bandon where we'll follow the Beach Loop Drive for viewing of Haystack Rock, Face Rock & Table Rock. We will also make a stop at Shore Acres State Park for a visit of their scenic gardens overlooking the Pacific Ocean. Then it's on to some of the world's largest and most beautiful sand dunes. Glistening valleys, vast hills of shifting sand, and the desert atmosphere make the dunes truly a must see! You will absolutely love the guided Interpretive Scenic Tour on one of our Famous Big Purple Buggies!





Following our Buggy Ride, we continue north along the coast for a visit to the Sea Lion Caves. Sea Lion Caves is a privately-owned wildlife preserve and bird sanctuary (since 1932) located on the beautiful and rugged Oregon Coast. Sea Lion Caves is America's largest sea cave and the year-round home of the Steller sea lion. An elevator installed in the rocky cliff is

available to transport guests to the viewing area above the caves. We'll continue north to Lincoln City and an overnight stay along the coast at the Chinook Winds Resort. Hotel & dining are located on the beach and adjacent to the Chinook Winds Casino – with entertainment, more dining options, boutique and more.



Day Five: Sunday

October 13, 2019

Breakfast is included at the hotel this morning before our group departure. Our first stop is at the always tasty Tillamook Cheese Factory. Here you'll have the opportunity to explore their new Visitor's Center where you can see the operations from viewing platforms, sample cheeses, shop or maybe enjoy an ice cream cone!

We'll leave the coast behind and head over to the scenic Willamette Valley of Oregon. Our first stop will be at the Evergreen Aviation & Space. With displays ranging from the elegant aeronautic designs of two bike mechanics – Orville and Wilbur Wright – to an actual Lockheed SR-71 Blackbird that can fly at speeds of over 2,000 miles per hour – there is a little something for everyone. The centerpiece of these aeronautic breakthroughs is the original Spruce Goose. Built entirely of wood due to wartime

restrictions on metals, this massive airplane stands as a symbol of American industry during World War II and built by Howard Hughes. We'll continue on through the Willamette Valley and make a quick stop at the Willamette Valley Fruit where you can purchase berries, pies, jams and so much more. The end of the day will find us in Roseburg, Oregon for our overnight stay. A hosted "Farewell to Oregon" dinner will be included tonight.



Day Six: Monday

October 14, 2019

Following breakfast at the hotel we'll board the coach to head south where we'll escape on a wild African Safari Drive Through Adventure and get up close to Ostrich, Watusi cattle, Lions and Zebra. Venture through the homes of Hippos and the land of the Scimitar Horned Oryx. Your Safari journey will take you through Southern Africa where the Rhino and Giraffe rule. After our visit to the Safari we'll begin our journey home with arrival home scheduled for early this evening.
