

Rising castle-like on the western hills, The Culinary Institute of America at Greystone is one of the Napa Valley's most historic and majestic properties. It's also one of the world's most unique and inspiring locations for culinary education. Built in the late 19th century and listed on the National Register of Historic Places, the impressive Greystone facility in St. Helena was once home to the Christian Brothers Winery. Here we'll enjoy a spectacular lunch, an educational tour and a visit to the Spice Island Marketplace.

And...There's something magical about a train ride. Add dining on the train at a table set with china and white linens, and the whole idea becomes even more romantic. The restored Pullman rail cars roll through some of Napa Valley's most scenic stretches. With brass accents, etched glass and plush sitting chairs, riding the wine country rails is like taking a trip back in time. You are sure to enjoy lunch on this, the exquisite Napa Valley Wine Train.

This tour also includes time to stroll main street in Saint Helena and explore their unique boutiques, galleries, coffee shops and more. We'll spend two nights in Napa at the beautiful Napa Winery Inn with breakfast each morning and evening wine tasting included.

# VISIT NAPA VALLEY

Day One: Monday April 27, 2020 CB - D

Group departure is scheduled this morning from Carson City & Sparks. Travel via deluxe motorcoach with coffee & continental breakfast served as we cross the Sierra's. (Refreshments on the coach are served throughout the entire tour). En route to Napa we'll stop at the Jelly Belly Factory where you'll have time for a tour, sampling their yummy treats and purchasing "Belly Flops" or other fun snacks.



This afternoon we'll check into the Napa Winery Inn with their comfortable guest rooms and guest focused service. Each morning you'll enjoy a complimentary hearty breakfast, while in the evening there is a nightly hosted wine tasting reception, featuring local wineries. Enjoy a dip in the pool, sit by the fire or relax in the hot tub after our day of travel.



This evening a hosted dinner is included at the casual Red Hen Mexican café – a local's favorite featuring traditional comfort and modern charm.

Day Two: Tuesday April 28, 2020 B - L

Following your breakfast at the hotel, we'll have a leisurely start to our morning as we travel to St Helena. We'll take a tour of the Culinary Institute of America school at Greystone, the former majestic home of Christian Brothers Winery. Our tour will take us past the kitchens and give us a sense of the lifestyle experienced by students of the CIA.



Then we'll meet in the spectacular Barrel room for a scrumptious lunch prepared by the students. Before we depart there'll be time to explore the Spice Island Marketplace, your one-stop shop for all things food and wine! Browse our books, learn something new about spices and herbs, talk to a chef-in-training, find your passion...all in one day.

We'll stop in the quaint & lovely downtown district of St.

Helena where shopping is unhurried, elegant, and fun. There are an abundant number of galleries, jewelry shops, boutiques, bookstores, coffee shops and more for you to discover. We'll make a short stop at Sutter Home Winery for tasting and a visit to their wine store – or maybe you'd prefer to explore their spectacular gardens. Then it's on to the Napa Winery Inn for our second nights stay.



Breakfast is included at the hotel this morning before our leisurely start of the day. A luxuriously vintage experience. Elegant 100-year-old railcars. A historic 150-year-old rail corridor. The Wine Train preserves a piece of Napa Valley history and proudly continues railroading traditions that are disappearing from the American landscape. The railroad that once transported visitors to a spa resort in Calistoga now brings guests from around the world on a 36-mile round-trip discovery to St. Helena and back, stopping at celebrated Napa Valley wineries along the way. Built entirely out of steel in 1915 by the Pullman Standard Company, they were the height of technological advancement of their time, with electric lights, steam heat, and arched windows. In 1987, the Napa Valley Wine Train



undertook an extensive restoration project to restore and reimagine the cars—Honduran mahogany paneling, brass accents, etched glass partitions, and velveteen fabric armchairs. Luxurious interiors evoking the spirit of opulent rail travel at the beginning of the twentieth century.

Following lunch, we'll board the coach for our return journey home, with comfort stops made en route. Return home scheduled for around 7-7:30pm.

### Tour Notes:

This tour is built around the beautiful Napa Valley, and the spectacular Greystone building and the Culinary Institute of America. Also included is the always popular, and elegant, Napa Valley Wine Train. Both locations, as well our hotel are ADA accessible. The walking tour at Greystone is approximately 30 minutes of walking, a few stairs and limited standing time. Train boarding requires steps up with rail, but a lift is available for guests that need assistance.

We require guests to advise us, at time of sign-up, of any physical or dietary restrictions so that we may work with you individually to assure you the best experience.
